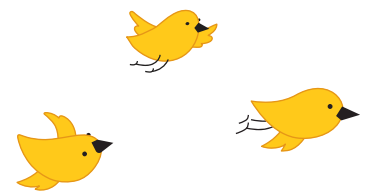
Enlightium's vision is to **nurture students** to honor God, care for others, and believe in themselves and their future.

Enlighthium Academy follows Washington State Transcript Guidelines.

Grade Point Average (GPA)

Calculation: GPA is calculated based on a weighted 5.0 rigor system.

Rank: Exact rank is used when calculated.

Honor (HR) courses result in +0.5 to the Weighted Grade Point Average (W-GPA), while Advanced Placement (AP), Dual Enrollment (DE), and Concurrent Credit (CC) courses result in +1.0 to the W-GPA.

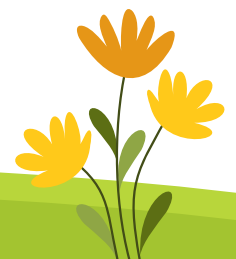
